**Track A: General Mathematics, Math 100 .This track will satisfy the requirements in most areas in Humanities and Social Science. And provides a basis in symbolic reasoning essential to descriptions of relationships and patterns in nature. Consult specific program requirements.

Track B: Algebra/Non-Calculus Based Statistics Preparation, MA 103. This track will satisfy the prerequisites for non-calculus based statistics required in Business and certain disciplines in Social Science, such as Behavioral Science. Consult specific program requirements.

Track C: Calculus Series, MA 210 or 211 (Prerequisites are MA 103 and MA 110 or equivalent in prior learning). This track will satisfy the basic calculus requirement in Biology , Pre-Med and Forensic Sciences.

Additionally MA 211 is required for Biology, Chemistry and Forensic Science; MA 211 and MA 311 are required for the major in Forensic Sciences and minor in Physics
