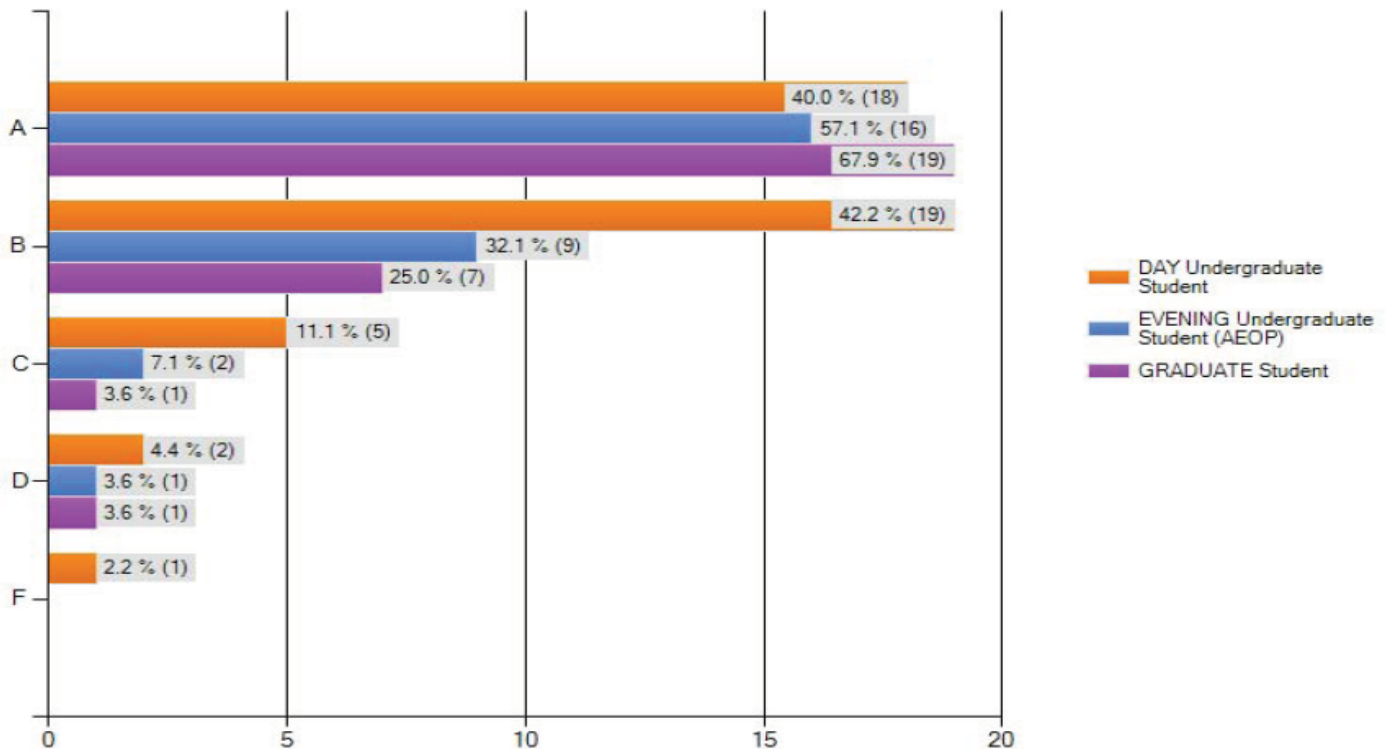

37% of Day Undergraduate (DUG) respondents named Criminal Justice as their major. The second most popular major was Education with just over 15%.

More the three quarters of Graduate student respondents majored in Education.

No students from the Master of Science in Counseling Psychology responded to the survey.

Most popular majors for Adult Evening and Online Program (AEOP) students were Psychology with nearly 29%, and Criminal Justice with 25%

Just over half (54%) of DUG students had begun their job search at the time of graduation. The rate of full time employment was also down from the Spring 2010 graduating class dropping from 42% to 34%.
