Earn up to \$2,775 to help pay for your education?

JOIN THE “STUDENTS IN SERVICE” PROGRAM!

“Students in Service” is a part-time AmeriCorps program that offers scholarships to college students who participate in community service. Your practicum/internship qualifies if it is non-paid.

HOW LARGE A SCHOLARSHIP CAN I EARN?

- 300 hours of service = \$1,175**
(1 year to complete)
- 450 hours of service = \$1,468**
(1 year to complete)
- 900 hours of service = \$2,775**
(2 years to complete)

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Log on to: www.StudentsInService.org
- Go to the **INFO FOR: STUDENTS** link, click on it and read the Pre-Service Overview and **complete the Pre- Service Reflection Questionnaire and then email helphi@hawaii.edu** and we will send you an orientation schedule (group orientations are done at the beginning of each semester in August & January.

WHAT ACTIVITIES QUALIFY?

- Academic and co-curricular service-learning
- Non-paid, academic internships with a service-focus
- Practicum hours, such as nursing, counseling, firefighting, student teachers who qualify, etc.
- Community service in the areas of education, public safety, environmental initiatives, community development, and human services
- Federal or State-funded community service work study positions (the only eligible paid positions)
- Most volunteer work, including tutoring, mentoring, stream restoration, volunteer recruitment, etc.
