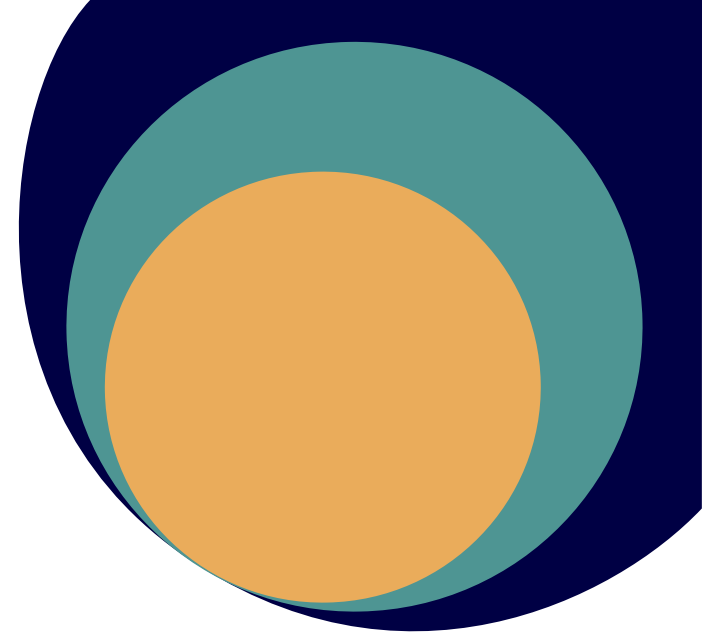

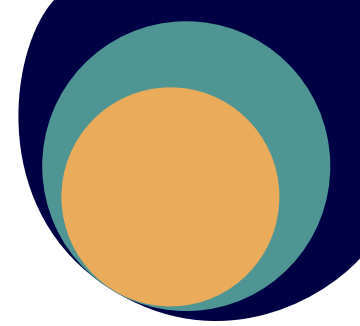

## Staying Healthy at Chaminade

The following documentation must be provided in order to complete Chaminade's health requirements.

\* **Day Undergraduate Health Form:** This form can be found in your acceptance packet or online at: [http://www.chaminade.edu/student\\_life/sss/hs-forms.php](http://www.chaminade.edu/student_life/sss/hs-forms.php)

\* **A negative Tuberculin (TB) examination** or chest x-ray administered no earlier than one year prior to enrollment. This requirement does not apply to students in the Marianist

\* **Proof of immunity to Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR):**

- Records showing dates for 2 doses of the MMR vaccine **OR**
- Positive MMR blood titers (tests). The lab results of this test must be signed by the MD, DO, APRN or PA with a note certifying immunity.

\* **Proof of Health Insurance: All Residence Hall Students, Intercollegiate Athletes, and International Students** are required to submit a copy of their current health insurance card.

Hawai'i Medical Service Association (HMSA) offers a discounted student health insurance plan to CUH students. A Blue Cross/Blue Shield provider, HMSA is the largest health organization in the state and makes its full range of services available to our students.
