All are welcome!

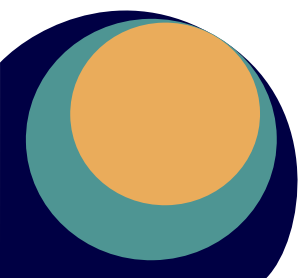
Time to say "A hui hou" to your student. Classes begin on Monday, August 23, 2010. Fall semester begins...now! Here we go!

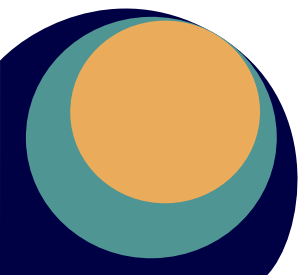
