

CHAMINADE UNIVERSITY

Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs Merit Scholarship

Institutional scholarship awarded to new first year and transfer students whose family are Hawaiian Civic Club members. Students must be nominated by their club president. This award is renewable for a maximum of four years provided the student remains in good academic standing.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students should see their club president. If a student is deemed worthy of recommendation, the president will complete a nomination form and write a letter of recommendation which will be sent to the Admissions Office of Chaminade University. Generally, only one student per civic club can be recommended.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must be:

- A United States citizen.
- A high school graduate with a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0 for first year students, or a prior college cumulative GPA of 2.50 for transfer students.
- Accepted to Chaminade University as an unconditionally admitted day student.
- Charged the maximum full-time day student tuition for the academic year.
- A member or dependent of a member of a Hawaiian Civic Club.
- Nominated by their Hawaiian Civic Club president (includes a letter or recommendation).
- Complete 20 hours of community service per academic semester (40 hours per academic year).

AWARD AMOUNT

This award is the value of one half of the full-time day tuition. Awards are credited against the recipient's tuition charge and may be increased according to need. Applicants are encouraged to file the FAFSA.

DEADLINE

Nominations should be submitted prior to the start of the semester for which the student intends to enroll.
