

## **CHAMINADE UNIVERSITY**

### **DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP**

Institutional scholarship awarded to new first-year or transfers who qualify to live on a Hawaiian Homestead property. Students must be nominated by their homestead association president. This award is renewable for a maximum of four years provided the student remains in good academic standing.

#### **Application Process:**

Students should see their homestead association president. If a student is deemed worthy of recommendation, the president will complete a nomination form and write a letter of recommendation, which will be sent to Chaminade University. Generally, only one student per homestead association can be recommended.

#### **Applicant must be:**

- A United States citizen.
- A high school graduate admitted to Chaminade as an unconditional or conditional first year student with a cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.0, or, a prior college cumulative GPA of 2.50 for transfer students.
- Charged the maximum day-student tuition for the academic year.
- A dependent of a current resident who holds a lease to a Hawaiian Home Lands property.
- Nominated by their Hawaiian Homestead Association President (includes a letter or recommendation).
- Complete 20 hours of community service per academic semester (40 hours per year)

#### **Award Amount**

This award is determined by the student's grade point average plus an additional \$1,500. Awards may be increased according to need and awards are credited against the recipient's tuition charge. Applicants are encouraged to file the FAFSA.

#### **Deadline**

Nominations should be submitted prior to the start of the semester for which the student intends to enroll.
