

CHAMINADE UNIVERSITY

HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE IMMERSION SCHOOLS OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

Institutional scholarship awarded to new first-year students or transfers who graduated from a Hawaiian Language Immersion School. Students must be nominated by their immersion school principal. This award is renewable for a maximum of four years provided the student remains in good academic standing.

Application Process

Students should see their immersion school principal. If a student is deemed worthy of recommendation, the principal will complete a nomination form and write a letter of recommendation, which will be sent to the Admissions Office of Chaminade University. Generally, only one student per immersion school per year can be recommended.

Applicant must be:

- A United States citizen.
- Accepted to Chaminade as a First Year student or transfer student.
- Charged the maximum day-student tuition for the academic year.
- A graduate of a Hawaiian Language Immersion school.
- Nominated by their immersion school principal (includes a letter of recommendation).
- Complete 20 hours of community service per academic semester (40 hours per year).

Award Amount

This award shall be the equivalent of the student's regular merit-based grant or scholarship (e.g. Regents and Presidential Scholarship, or Leadership or transfer grant), plus an additional \$1,500. Awards may be increased according to need and will be credited against the recipient's tuition charge. Students are encouraged to file the FAFSA.

Deadline

Nominations should be submitted prior to the start of the semester for which the student intends to enroll.
